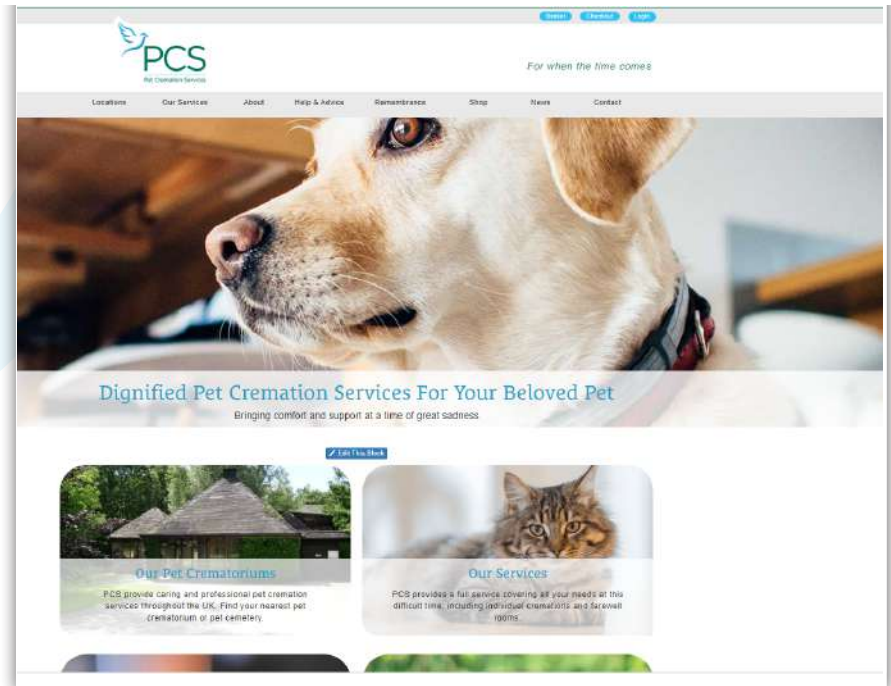

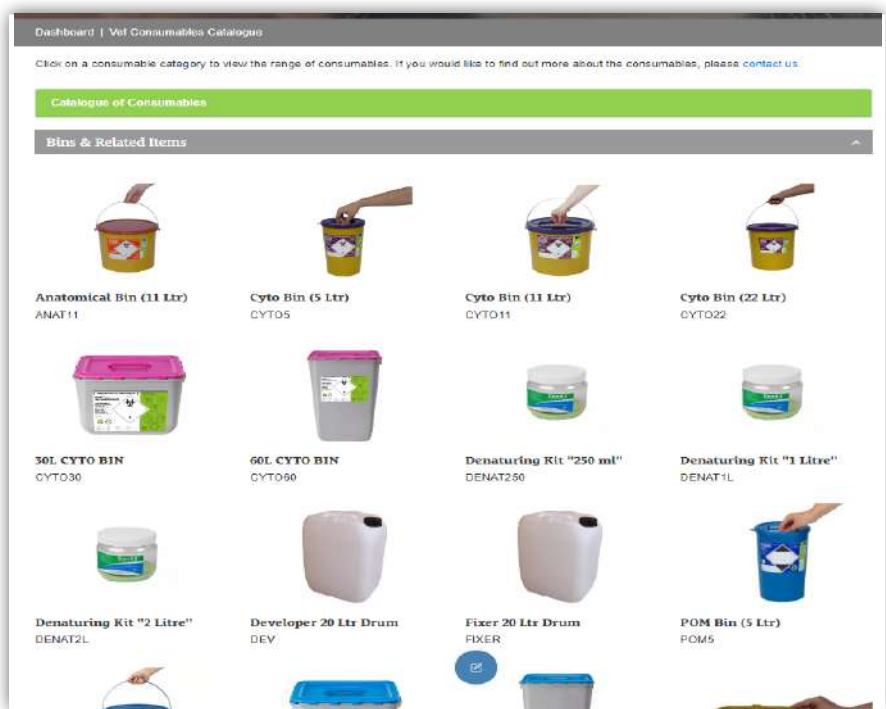

### What is Waste Pre-Acceptance?

The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations require that all veterinary practices are subject to a pre-acceptance audit prior to collection via a contractor. Failing to complete a pre-acceptance audit, or undertaking the correct pre-acceptance audit procedure will ensure that the suitable documentation and audit trail for managed waste is available.
